
Thanks very much to coach **Sean Dawson** for organizing the team photos for the morning and evening groups again this year. I'll include the photos in the next newsletter.

#### Ask the Coach

Dear Coach: I struggle with my kicking compared to my lane-mates. Any suggestions? Poor Kicker

Dear P. Kicker: Ankle flexibility is key to kicking well. Here's an article by **Gary Hall, Sr.** that talks about that: <a href="https://swimswam.com/freestyle-kicking-power-requires-plantar-flexibility/">https://swimswam.com/freestyle-kicking-power-requires-plantar-flexibility/</a>. The ankle flexibility exercises start at 4:30. Stick with the first one -- the freestyle quad pushups look very difficult!

**Dear Coach:** I've heard that core strength is important for swimming. Can you recommend some exercises to help? Want Abs of Steel

Dear Coach: Everyone talks about body rotation in freestyle. Is it possible to rotate too much? Working on Freestyle

Dear W.o. Freestyle: It's unusual to rotate too much, as many swimmers don't rotate enough. However, here's a video on over-rotation and how to correct it: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yMpHulcTiQQ.

#### **Masters Swimming Competitions**

This season (2018-2019), you have several options for registration for competitions:

- 1. You can register with Masters Swimming Ontario (MSO). This allows you to compete in Ontario only, and in meets sanctioned by MSO only. Your times will probably be accepted by MSC (e.g. for the Top 20 rankings) but will probably not be recognized by FINA (e.g. for World Records). This costs \$15 for Sept 1<sup>st</sup> to Aug 31<sup>st</sup>. This registration can be done quite quickly, so it doesn't have to be done very far in advance of the competition you are interested in. (You can also pay a \$5 registration fee for each MSO-sanctioned competition that you enter, but then you would <u>not</u> be swimming for Carleton Masters.)
- 2. If you wish to compete outside Ontario, or in Ontario SO-sanctioned meets, you must register with Swimming Ontario (SO) as a Carleton Masters swimmer. This costs \$65 for Sept 1<sup>st</sup> to Aug 31<sup>st</sup>. Registration several weeks in advance of the meet deadline is required, as you will not be eligible to compete until your registration has been processed by SO.
- 3. You can register with both MSO and SO. This costs \$75 for Sept 1st to Aug 31st.

Note that the Carleton Masters club code is CARMA.

For all of the above, if you haven't registered before, please send me your name, gender, date of birth, address and phone number. You may pay by e-transfer, cash, or cheque payable to me (**Lynn Marshall**). Note that the above costs include a contribution to the club registration fee.

Many Ontario meets, including most local meets, are MSO sanctioned. If you want to compete in (for example) Montreal or at Nationals, then SO registration is required.

Masters meets are identified as "Masters" under meet type. If it says "sanctioned" the meet package should be available. Masters is a members-only program with no student discount. Registration can be done in person or by phone: 613-520-4480. Note that membership information will be in the old (CLASS) system, while the program registration will be done in the new (FUSION) system. Eventually the new system will allow on-line registration for Masters, which will make life easier for everyone. Note that the new system does \*not\* have barcodes. When you register, please identify the program(s) by the name and time of the swims. As per usual, for Winter, if you want to swim on Saturdays, that is a separate registration.
