# 2022 Ontario University Athletics (OUA) Championships at the University of Toronto Pool March 10-12, 2022

# **Carleton University Ravens Report**

With the pandemic starting just weeks after the 2020 OUA Championships, and with only virtual unofficial competitions in the 2020-2021 season, the swimmers were thrilled to participate in the OUA Championships this year! The meet took place a month later than usual, due to the on-again-off-again training this season. In addition, the sessions were single-gender and timed finals, with no mingling between spectators and swimmers, and masks were worn except while swimming.

The meet was a great success for Carleton with the women finishing 6<sup>th</sup> overall (up from 10<sup>th</sup> in 2020), and the men finishing 5<sup>th</sup> (up from 9<sup>th</sup> in 2020). This improvement led to Coach **Pierre Lafontaine** winning the OUA Swim Coach of the Year for both women and men! A well-deserved honour.

The meet highlights included three bronze medals for the men by **Finn Tuck** in 100m backstroke, **Cam Teasdale** in 50m breaststroke, and the 4 x 50m medley relay of **Yazan Al Bawwab, Cam, Nathan Landry, and Finn**. The men's relay was in the first heat of two, so very impressive! **Cam** had previous qualified for U Sports Championships in the 50m breaststroke and added a second event, 100m breaststroke. Everyone swam very well, with seasonal bests across the board and over 90% best times.

Thank you to the swim leadership team of **Andrew Beckett**, **Aoife McGrory**, and **Isabelle Goupil** for their assistance with organizing the trip and helping with splits. Thanks also to **Peter Zhang** for timing session one, as well as swimming in the meet.

The women scored 184 points, nearly three times their 64 points from 2020. The men scored 258.5 points, over double the 116 from 2020.


