

Carleton Ravens Swim Team Meet Report: Montreal Neptune Natation Invitational: December 3-5, 2021

From Friday December 3 to Sunday December 5, most of the team attended the Neptune Natation Invitational at the Montreal Olympic Pool. This was an age group meet, and was substituted into our meet schedule due to Divisionals being cancelled due to Ontario's COVID restrictions.

The team left Ottawa at 5am on Friday, so the first day was a long one. Then overnight Saturday there was a malfunction with the main pool temperature with swimmers estimating that the temperature was in the high 50s F on Sunday morning. Extra lifeguards were needed for Sunday's heats as so many swimmers struggled with breathing in such cold water and were unable to finish their races. After heats, the unfortunate (but correct) decision was made to cancel the distance events scheduled for Sunday afternoon and the Sunday evening finals.

In most events, there were both "A" and "B" finals of 8 swimmers each in the 17 and over category, unless there were fewer than 16 entries.
